

Boise Valley Council Traditions

1. At the time of a member's death a card is sent to her family and chapter. A donation of \$10.00 will be made in memory of the member to the Endowment Fund, Scholarship Fund or her favorite charity
(Responsible Officers: Council Treasurer and Secretary)
2. Council President may be presented with a gavel guard pin, from the Beta Sigma Phi International Gift Catalog, at Founder's Day. Other City Council officers may also receive their officer pins if the budget allows. *(Responsible Officer: Vice President)*
3. The outgoing President may be asked to sit in on the new Executive Board's meetings.
4. The Order of the Rose, Silver Circle, Golden Circle, Diamond Circle, and Platinum Circle recipients may be presented with their certificates at Founder's Day or at the Ritual Event. *(Responsible Officer to Order: Chapter Vice President or designee)*
5. Council will supply the roses for Ritual Night with chapters then reimbursing Council at the May Council meeting. *(Responsible Officer to Order: Council Vice President or designee)*
6. All Chapter Vice Presidents are responsible for requesting and receiving all pins and certificates needed for their chapters Candidate/Candidates to be used at a possible Council Ritual Event.
7. The outgoing President will be responsible for ordering roses for installation of the new officers.
8. One-half (1/2) the ticket cost of the meal of the Founder's Day meal for Council Officers in attendance will be paid with Council funds.
9. Honorary members may be included in the Founder's Day program *(Responsible Officer: Vice President)*
10. A "Ritual" event may be planned and scheduled by the Vice President.
